CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Admissions made by the College are provisional
- Certified copies of Transfer Certificate , Marks Card, Caste Certificate and Income certificate in the prescribed proforma should accompany the application. The originals must be submitted without fail at the time of admission.
- 3. Students from outside Karnataka State should enclose migration certificate.
- 4. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- 5. Students are required to fill in the forms with extreme care. For any discrepancy therein, they shall not hold the College or the Management responsible.
- Students are required to come along with their parents/guardians at the time of admission.
- 7. Subjects once offered will not be changed under any circumstances.
- 8. The College office working time is 10 a.m to 4, p.m. on all working days with lunch break between 1.00 p.m. and 2.00 p.m.
- 9. Employees are not admitted without the permission of their employers.
- 10. The students are required to put in 75% attendance in each subject to become eligible to appear for the qualifying examination.
- 11. It is the responsibility of the students to fill in the application /Scholarship/ exam forms etc., correctly. They alone are responsible for any errors therein.
- 12. Orientation programmes are compulsory, failure to attend the programmes will lead to penal fee or even cancellation of admission.
- 13. The students should go through the notice boards every day for any information.
- 14. The Extra Curricular Activities (ECA): Participation in ECA like NCC/NSS/ Sports/Seminar/Community Services/Music, Drama etc., is compulsory.
